GUIDE FOR REVIEWERS

If your suggestion for a book review was accepted by the editors, or if you have been invited to review a book by the editorial board, please adhere to the style guide detailed in the Authors' Instructions (available to download from the website). The board will provide a copy of the book to be reviewed.

Your book review should not exceed 1,000 words; in exceptional cases we will accept reviews of 1,500 words. In case you devote a review to a number of books in the same field of scholarly research (with a maximum of three), your review article may exceed the prescribed amount of words.

The review should provide an objective and yet critical and fair discussion of the book(s) under review. It should discuss the overall idea and scope of the book, as well as the main arguments that lead up to the central thesis. In case of strong disagreement with the author's argument, the reviewer should provide solid arguments against the author's thesis. A balanced review will both point out areas of improvement as well as underline the book's strengths. We do not encourage a mere chapter-by-chapter description but may accept it as long as the overall aim of the book is duly and properly addressed.

Reviews are reviewed internally by members of the Editorial Team or Board.
